In April 2024, our newly formed "Giving Team" introduced The Giving Circle, a framework for organizing and recognizing donors that differs from traditional, hierarchal models linking money to voice and power. PRIDE AND ALLY COMMUNITY WELLNESS

Red Horse Center, and more specifically, co-founder, Ulla Frederiksen - Psychologist, have a rich history in providing inclusive, LGBTQ+ friendly mental health services.

In the Spring of 2024, Red Horse sought to deepen our process by creating the "Pride and Ally Community Wellness" program, in response to a call for proposals from Allegan County Community Foundation.

It is a collection of services offered in support of the LGBTQIA+ communities in West Michigan and beyond. We aim to help increase safety, visibility, acceptance, and allyship while providing trauma-informed mental health and wellness.

2024 was a formative year, with deep collaboration with our friends at Campit Outdoor Resort, including the inaugural "Thrive Trans Personal Wellness Workshop." It was a positive and moving experience. We are grateful for the opportunities to serve, and encouraged by the remarkable feedback. Looking forward to more collaborations in 2025!

We have some elder Aunties, Juniper and Maya, who require more specialized care in their later years, although they're doing well, much improved from some recent injuries.

Sydney is managing some gastro-intestinal developments, while the 10-year-old youngsters, Prince and Freya lead the Equine Greeter Team. Freya has had a long arc of healing from her traumatic history and is doing better than ever. She has even brought in a full Horse Sponsorship for 2025, contributing to our Herd Care Fund. Gus and Clara are thriving in their minipaddock with occasional visits with the bigs.
